

5. Stand Specifications

5.1 SPACE ONLY STAND SPECIFICATION

Stand Limits

No part of the stand or display may extend or project beyond the allotted dimensions of the space. Stand designs must be submitted for approval by 17 July 2009.

Flooring

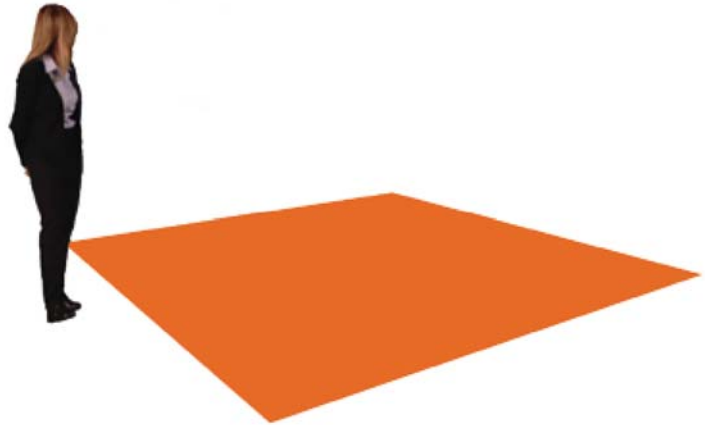
Many exhibitors will require bare floor space for display of natural stone, ceramic tile products and machinery. Please refer to the Centres flooring requirements in "Stands" section.

Walls

Each exhibitor is responsible for erecting a partition wall between the exhibitor's site and the adjoining site.

Partition Walls

Harry the Hirer have designed load bearing timber partition walls which can either be painted in the Dulux colour of your choice, or left raw. (Refer to page 36). Please contact Laura Cvetkoski at Harry the Hirer on 02 9666 8699 to discuss this option.



Spotlights

Lighting is NOT included in a space only stand. Please contact Laura Cvetkoski at Harry the Hirer on 02 9666 8699 to discuss this option.

Power

Power is NOT included. Power points may be ordered through our contractor Harry the Hirer or by completing the lighting, power and electrics form.

5.2 SHELL SCHEME STAND SPECIFICATION

Stand Design

All stand designs must be submitted to the Organiser for approval at least 6 weeks prior to the Exhibition. The Organiser reserves the right to reject any design.

Height

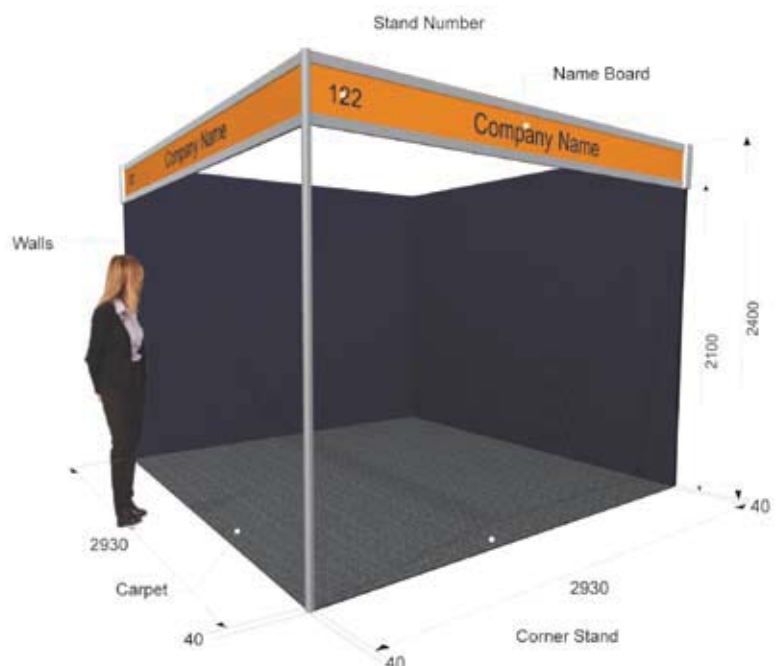
The Shell Scheme will be 2400 mm in overall height.

Flooring

The Convention Centre floor will be covered with Charcoal Gray Carpet Tiles (6mm thick) supplied by Harry the Hirer unless you are laying an alternative flooring on your stand.

Walls

The walls of the stand will consist of black Fronrunner walls. Panel thickness is 40 mm.



Partition Walls

Harry the Hirer have designed load bearing timber partition walls which can either be painted in the Dulux colour of your choice, or left raw. Please contact Laura Cvetkoski at Harry the Hirer on 02 9666 8699 to discuss this option.

Fascia

The Fascia consists of a white panel supported in an Octanorm frame. Fascias will be provided for all open sides of shell scheme stands. Clear height under the fascia is 2100h.

Company Name & Stand Number

The company name style is uniform and may not be altered. Names will be printed in upper and lower case using orange computer cut vinyl lettering. Company names will be installed over each open fascia. Each sign will be a maximum of 25 characters including spaces.

Spotlights

Spotlights will be track mounted and fitted to the back of the fascia of all stands. Two (2) 120

watt spotlights will be supplied per 9 square metres of stand space.

Power

One four amp single power outlet is included in the shell scheme package. Additional power points may be ordered by completing the Lighting/Power order form in the Exhibitor Handbook.

Additions

Stand upgrades are available from the Shell Scheme stand builder Harry the Hirer. Please contact Laura Cvetkoski at Harry the Hirer on 02 9666 8699 to discuss this option.

Items which can be used on walls

When attaching anything to walls, exhibitors are asked to use velcro, double-sided adhesive tape or approved shelves and hooks, all are available from Harry the Hirer if required.

Items not to be used on walls

Pins, staples, screws, nails, bolts, glue & paint will permanently damage the panels, and Exhibitors are requested not to use them.

5.3 PARTITION WALLS OPTION

Set yourself apart from the competition, literally! Our partition wall option can be painted in any Dulux colour you like or decorate it yourself, and create a stylish backdrop to showcase your product.

partition wall must be of solid construction, suitably decorated on the reverse side to the requirements of the adjoining exhibitor, and must not carry any advertising material where the elevation overlooks the lower stand.

Partition Walls

A number of exhibitors who are building their stands naturally share sites with other companies. One of their prime considerations will relate to construction and decoration of partition walls that divide stands.

In most cases companies located on either side of the wall will share the construction cost. Harry the Hirer have designed load bearing timber partition walls which can either be painted in the Dulux colour of your choice, or left raw.

Exhibitors can talk to Harry the Hirer about adding shelving or the addition of their name in an appropriate location. Please refer to the attached drawings. If you require any additional information please contact Laura Cvetkoski at Harry the Hirer on 02 9666 8699.

Please note: If an exhibitor chooses to design a wall taller than their adjacent exhibitor, they are then responsible for both sides of the partition wall 2.4 metres and above. The
